#### Introduction to Giving: A Heart of Worship

# 1. Tithes: Honoring God First What is a Tithe?

The tithe, meaning "tenth," is the biblical principle of giving the first 10% of your income back to God. It is an act of obedience and trust, acknowledging God as your ultimate source and provider.

#### **Biblical Foundation**

- Malachi 3:10 (NLT): "Bring all the tithes into the storehouse so there will be enough food in my Temple. If you do," says the Lord of Heaven's Armies, "I will open the windows of heaven for you. I will pour out a blessing so great you won't have enough room to take it in! Try it! Put me to the test!"
- Proverbs 3:9-10 (NRSV): "Honor the Lord with your substance and with the first fruits of all your produce; then your barns will be filled with plenty, and your vats will be bursting with wine."

### Why Give Tithes?

- Tithing keeps our hearts aligned with God's will.
- It supports the work of the church in ministry, outreach, and missions.
- It is a tangible way of expressing faith in God's provision.

# **Biblical Foundation**

 2 Corinthians 9:6-8 (NLT): "Remember this—a farmer who plants only a few seeds will get a small crop. But the one who plants generously will get a generous crop. You must each decide in your heart how much to give. And don't give reluctantly or in response to pressure. 'For God loves a person who gives cheerfully.' And God will generously provide all you need. Then you will always have everything you need and plenty left over to share with others."

# Why Give Offerings?

- Offerings allow you to partner with God in meeting specific needs, both in the church and the community.
- It is an opportunity to express love for others and gratitude for God's goodness.

# 3. Corporate Giving: Building for the Future What is Corporate Giving?

They still kept bringing him freewill offerings every morning, so that all the artisans who were doing every sort of task on the sanctuary came, each from the task being performed, and said to Moses, 'The people are bringing much more than enough for doing the work that the Lord has commanded us to do.'"
